DISASTER PLAN FOR PETS



Plan ahead to minimize panic. Be aware of pet friendly hotels on your evacuation route, and have a friend or family member you can count on should you not be able to make it home to safely secure your pet.

Have a Grab and Go bag ready. This is critical if you need to leave in a hurry. This bag should include food and water, medications, ID tags and photos, vaccination records, and pet supplies.

Stay informed of weather changes. Paying attention to updates will help you know what action to take and when to act. This includes knowing how to safely shelter in place and where to evacuate should you need to leave.
